FISH FRY FRIDAY'S ARE HERE!!!!!!!

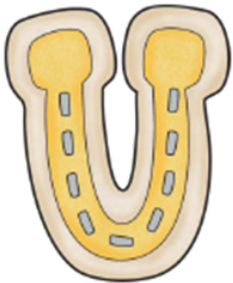
