What We Are Learning:

Math: Next, the class will begin to practice subtraction in the tens, hundreds, and thousands.

Reading. Students this week are reading the story, "City Critters." They will continue to study the concepts of drawing conclusions and summary. This weeks vocabulary words are: biologist, urban, skyscraper, migrating, laboratories, and observation. Test on Friday.

Spelling. The words this week have the er and or sounds. This weeks words are: porch, fort, sport, storm, tore, burn, curb, hurt, hurry, nurse, urban, curb, hurt, hurry, nurse, urban, forget, bird, short, before, biologist, urban, skyscraper, migrating, laboratories, and observation. If students, receive 100% on Thursday's pretest they will not have to take the test on Friday.

Social Studies. The class will continue to study about the British, French, and Indians. The class will also receive a chapter review. The test is scheduled for next Monday.

Science. The class will have a test on Tuesday. Next, the class will learn how living things depend on one another, how living things get energy, and how energy moves through the food chain.

English. The class will begin to learn about the different types of nouns and identifying them.
